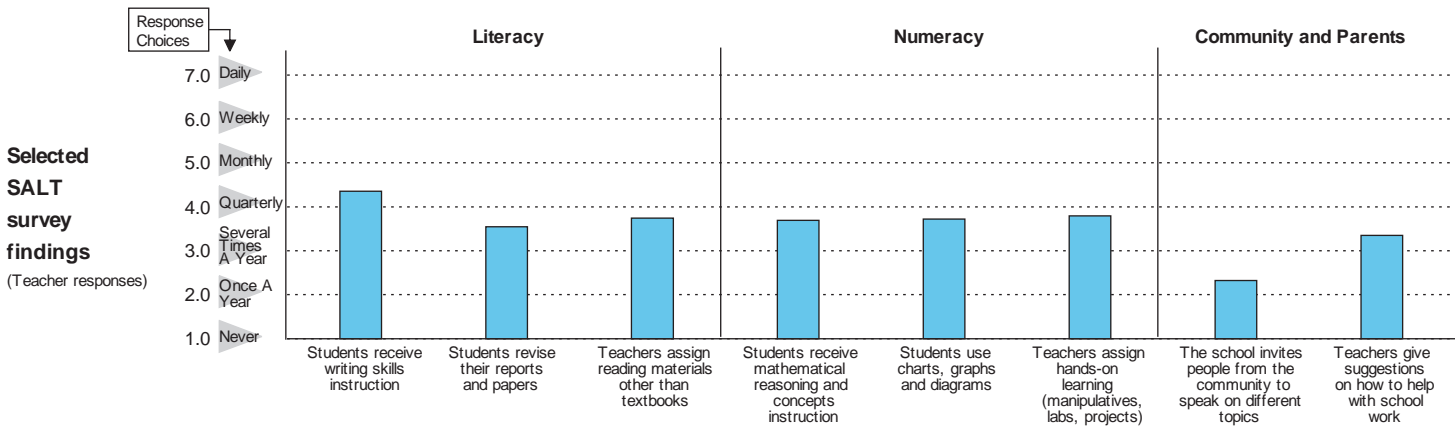
RI WRITING ASSESSMENT: 55% of the students taking the RI Writing Assessment scored proficient or exemplary on the test.
