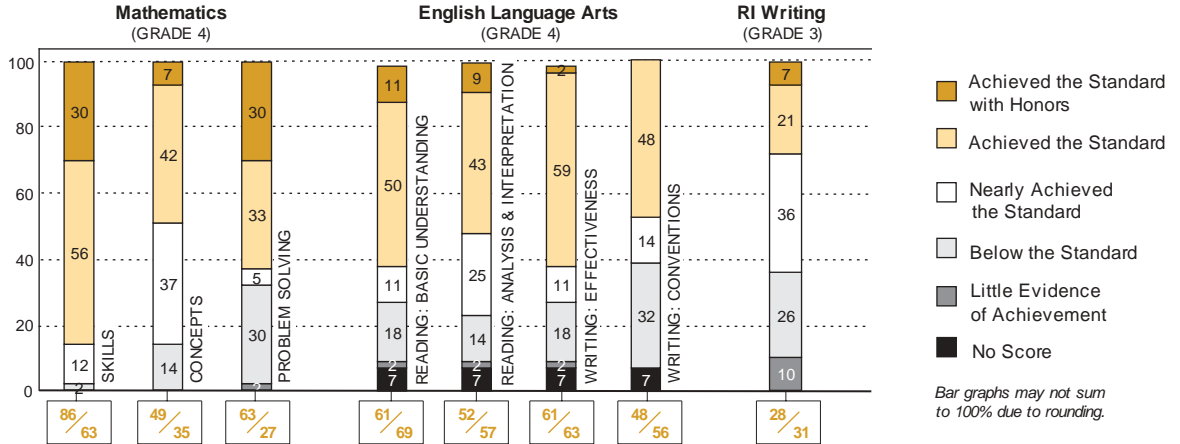

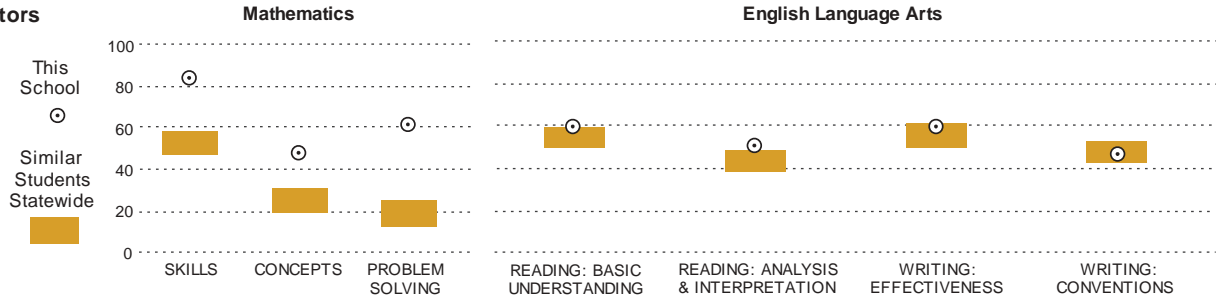
Percentage of students at each performance level

Total percent proficient in each subtest



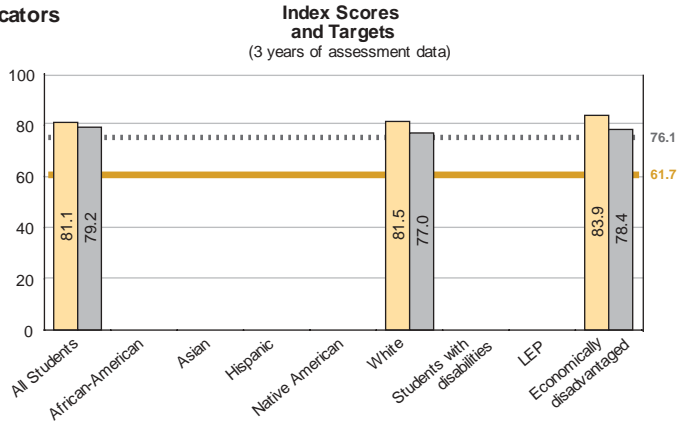

Percentage of students who met or exceeded the standard compared with the percentage of similar students statewide



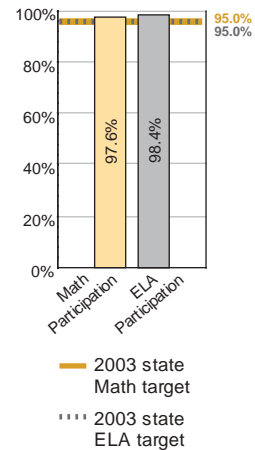

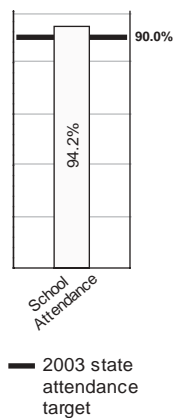

Attendance Rate and Target (1 year of data)

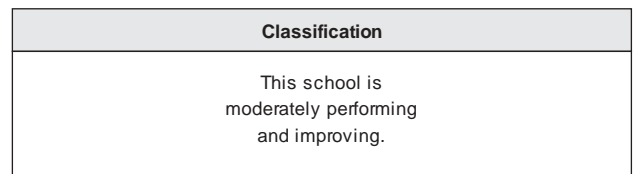
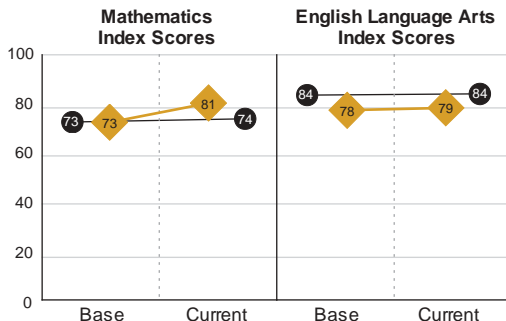

Student achievement over the past four years

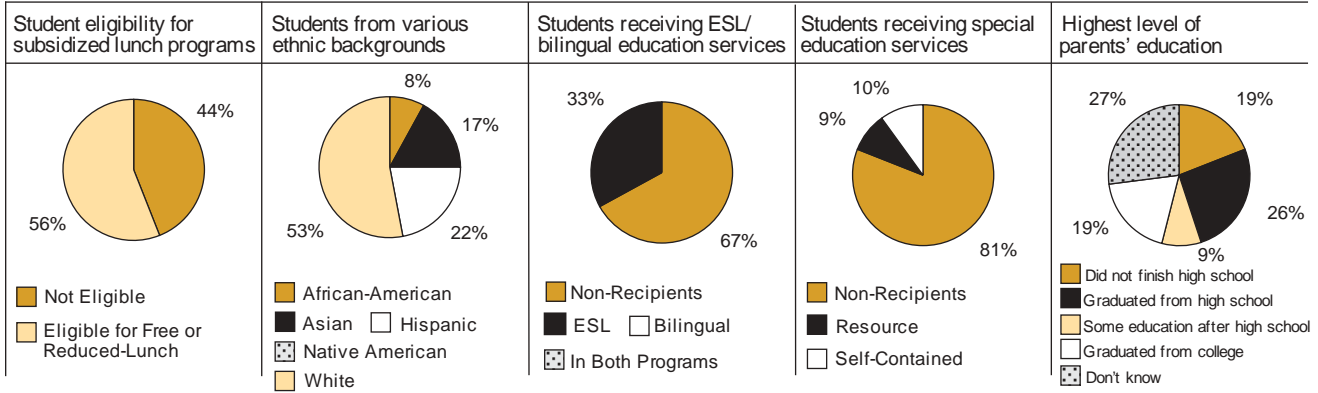

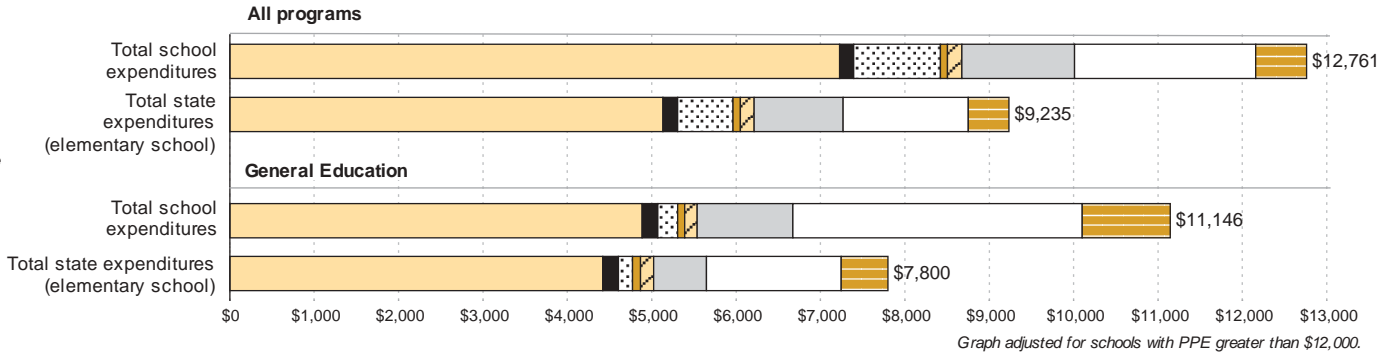

Characteristics of students attending this school



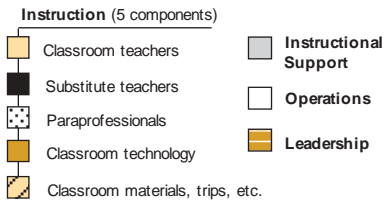

Key for school expenditures areas

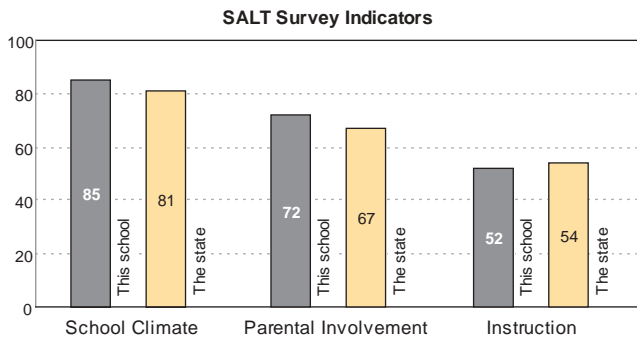


Per pupil expenditures by program

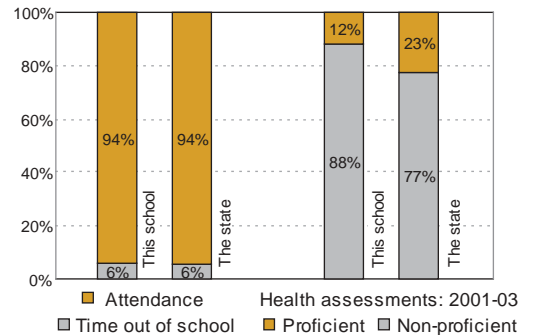
