

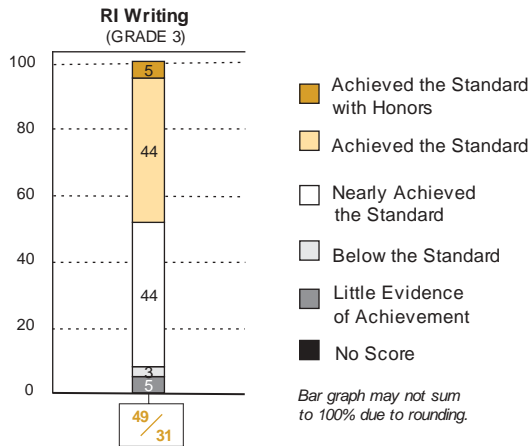
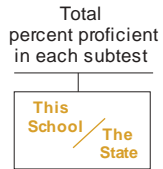

Percentage of students at each performance level



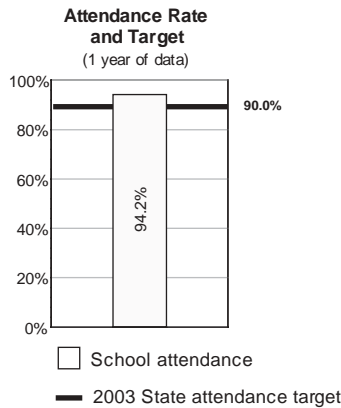

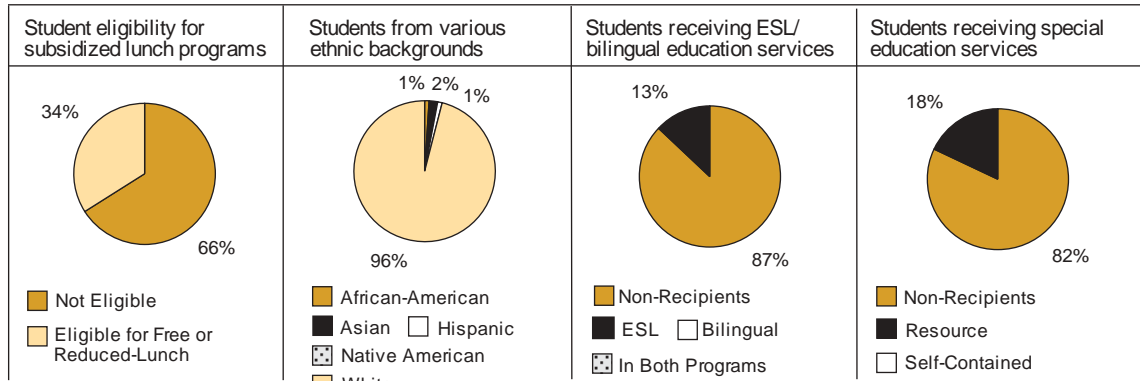

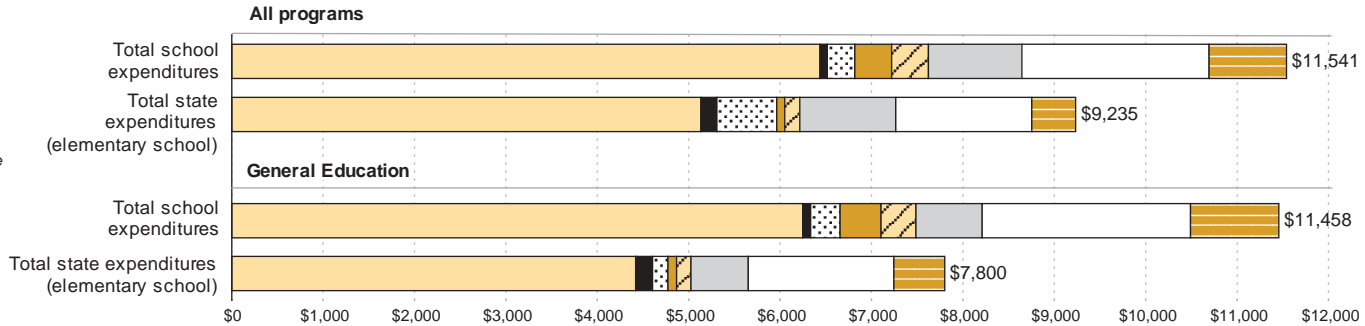

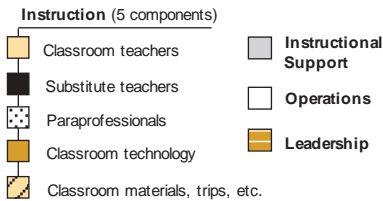

Key for school expenditures areas

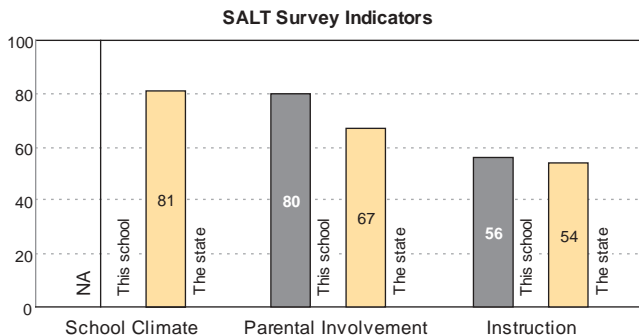


Per pupil expenditures by program

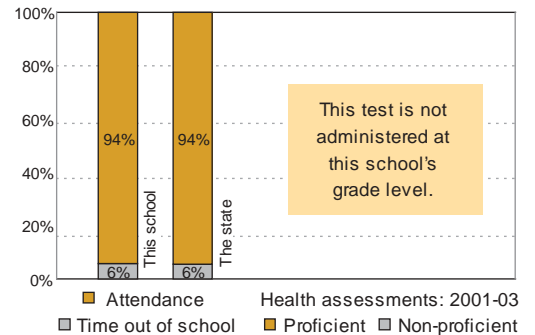
