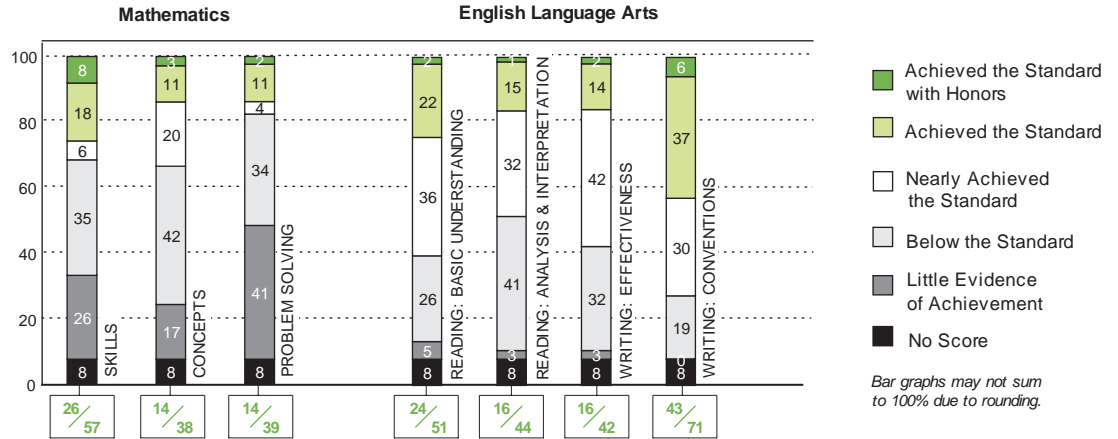

Percentage of students at each performance level

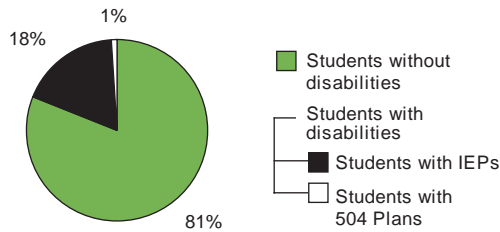

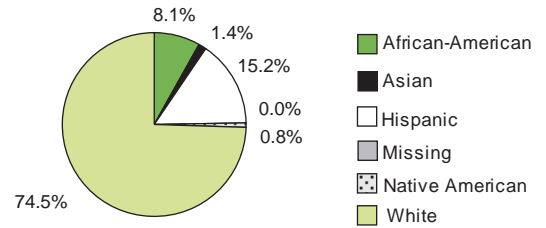

Students with disabilities from various ethnic backgrounds

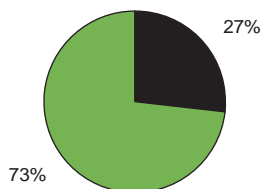


Percent proficient on the New Standards Reference Exams by category of students with disabilities

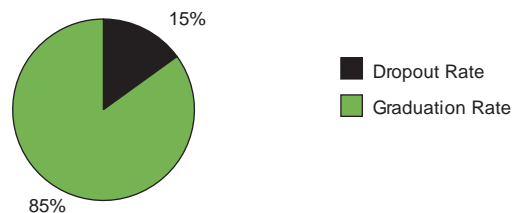

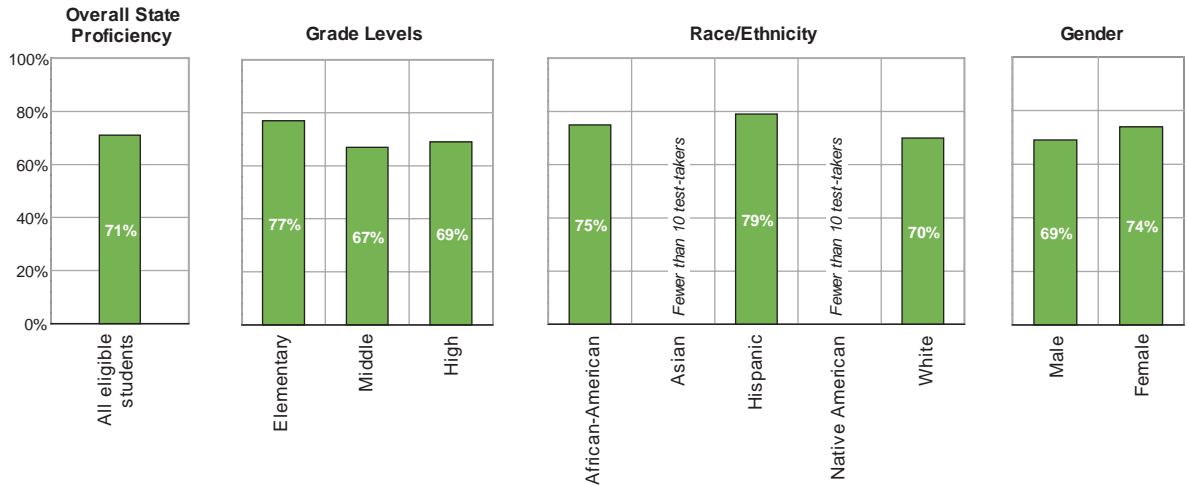

Alternate Assessment performance in the State of Rhode Island

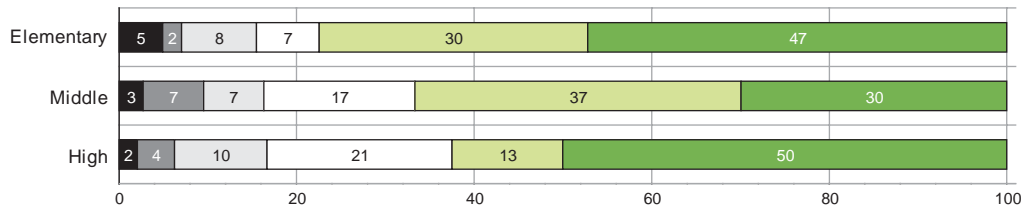
Percent of students achieving the standard on the Alternate Assessment



Percent of students at each performance level on the Alternate Assessment

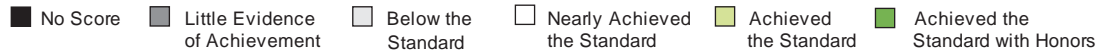
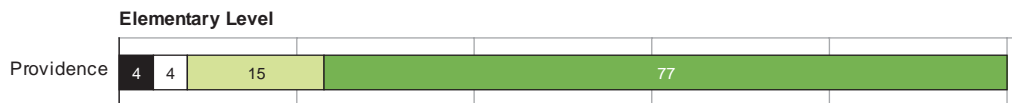
