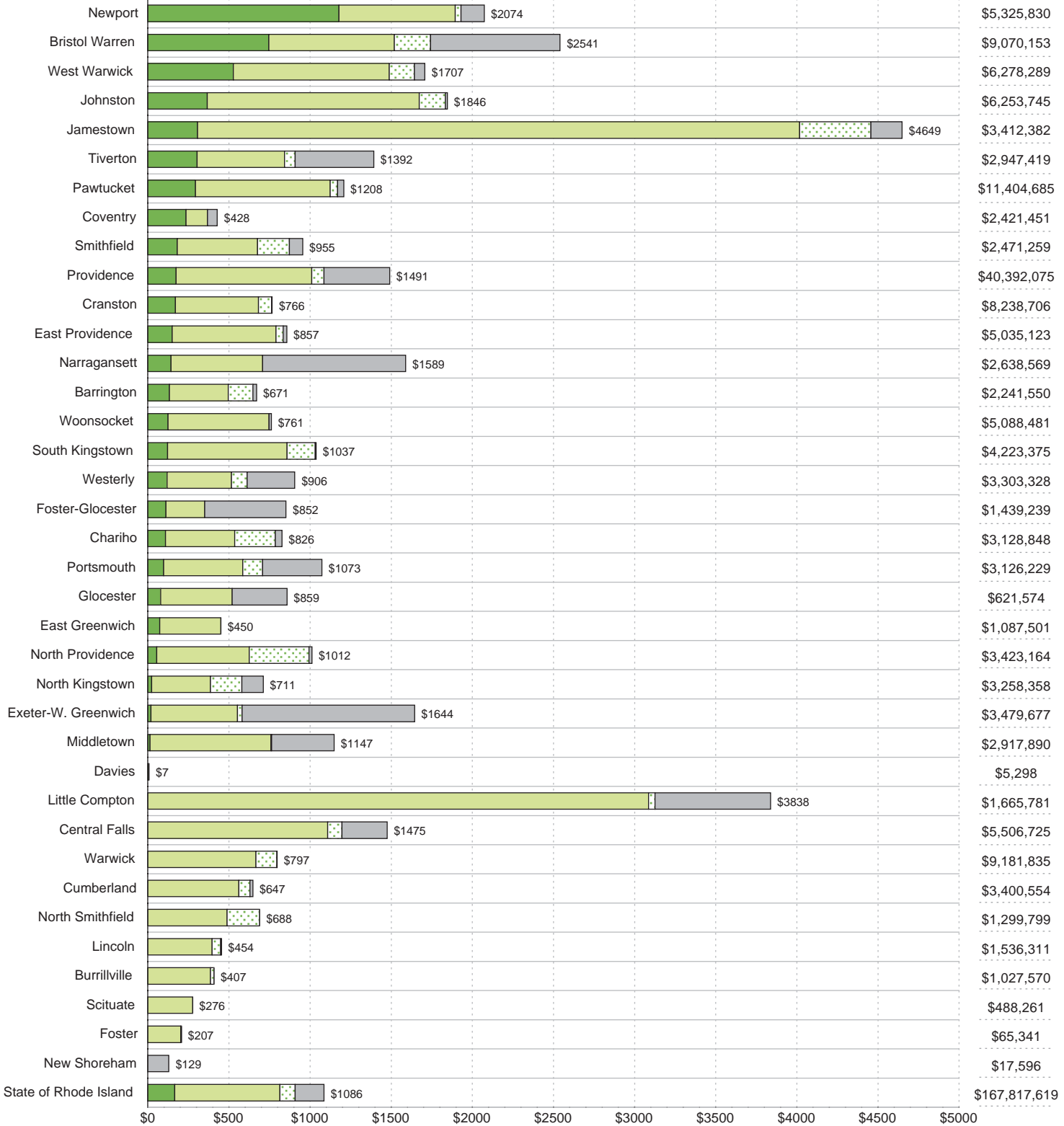


Equity and Adequacy of Resources: Out-of-District Expenditures

Rhode Island

Out-of-district expenditures (per pupil)

Districts are sorted by retiree benefits.

Retiree benefits: Health care, severance, life insurance, etc.

Tuitions: For district students who attend out-of-district public or nonpublic schools. (Little Compton and Jamestown pay tuition to send their students to high school out of district.)

Transportation: Costs incurred by students who attend private, parochial, or charter schools, as well as those whose district has no high school.

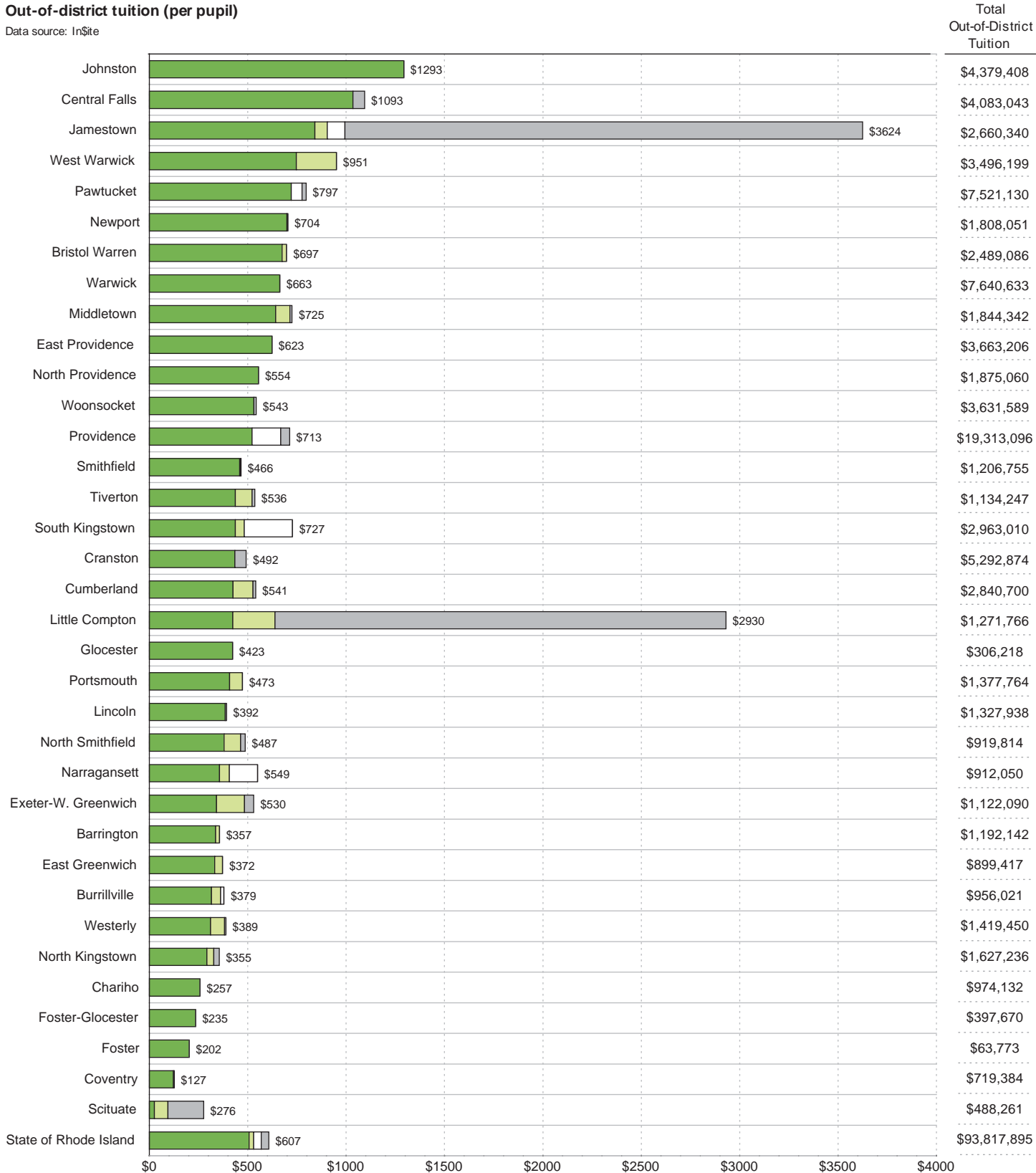
Other: Adult education, community services, capital outlays, debt service, etc.

Districts are sorted by Special Education Per Pupil Expenditure.

Per-pupil expenditures show the expenditures as per all pupils in the school - not just as per all students with disabilities.
 Little Compton and Jamestown pay tuition to send their students to high school out of district.
