**No Child Left Behind Categories**

- Adequate Yearly Progress:** Schools "with caution" and schools making "Insufficient Progress" did not make Adequate Yearly Progress. All other schools made Adequate Yearly Progress.
- Identified for School Improvement:** Schools that have not made Adequate Yearly Progress for two or more years in a row are Identified for School Improvement.
