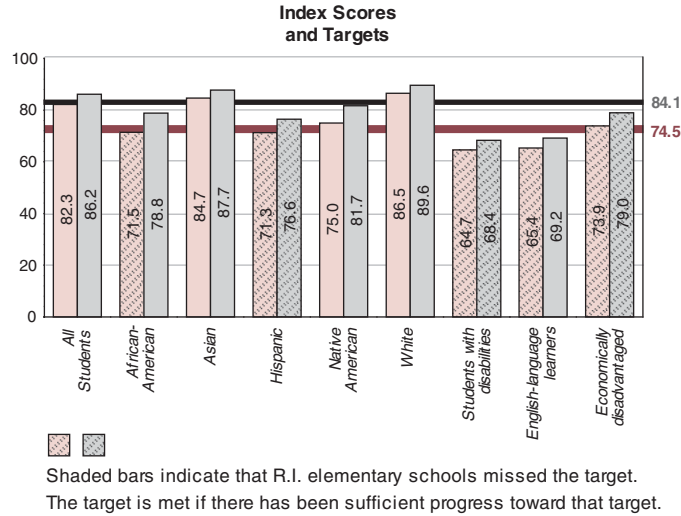


RIDE uses index scores to determine school and district classifications. The index scores are based on the performance levels of students at all grade levels in the state tests of reading, writing, and mathematics. Scores are calculated for all students and for eight student groups. Under NCLB, RIDE also sets targets for participation, attendance, and graduation rates.

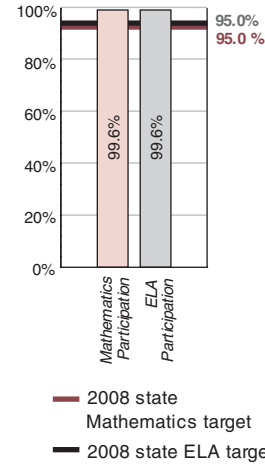

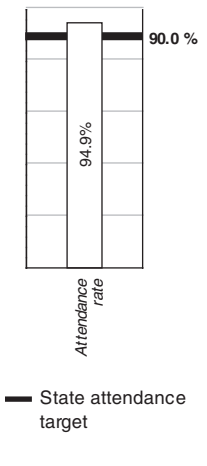

Participation Rates and Targets



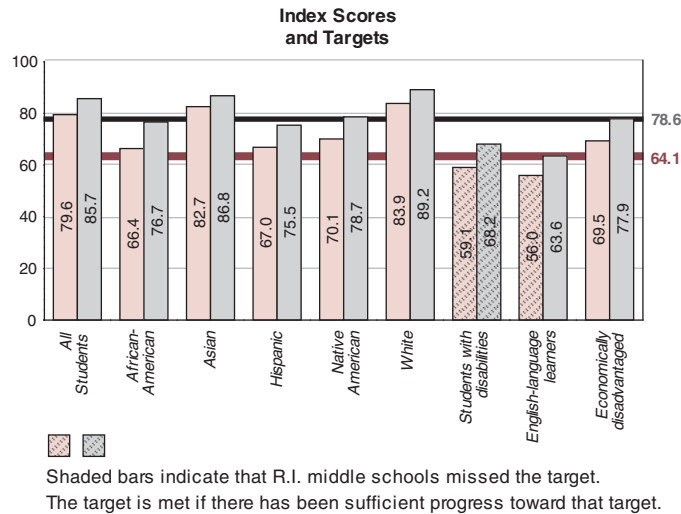
Attendance Rate and Target



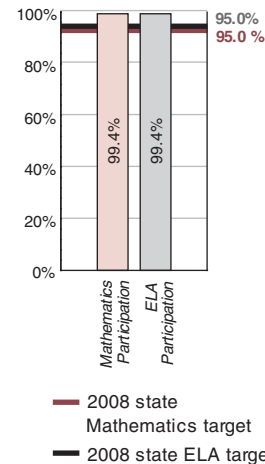

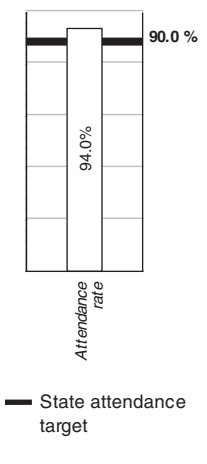

Participation Rates and Targets



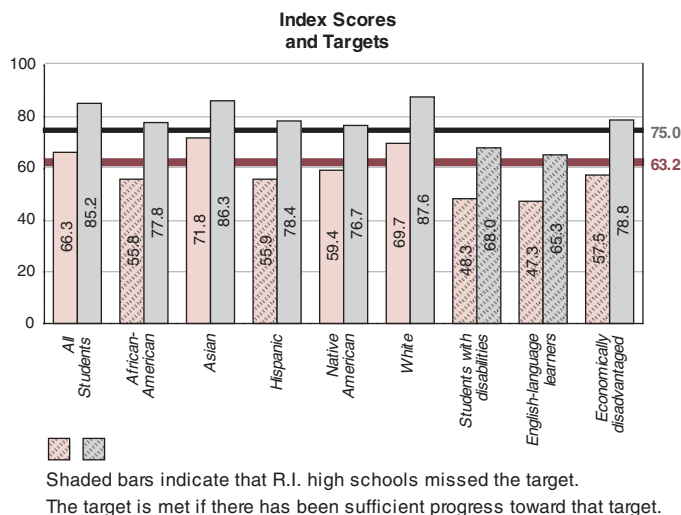
Attendance Rate and Target



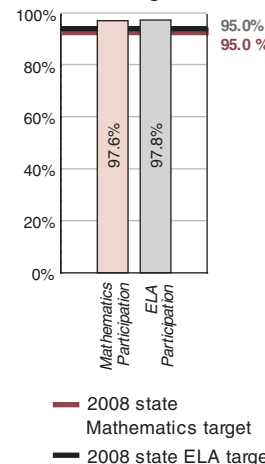
