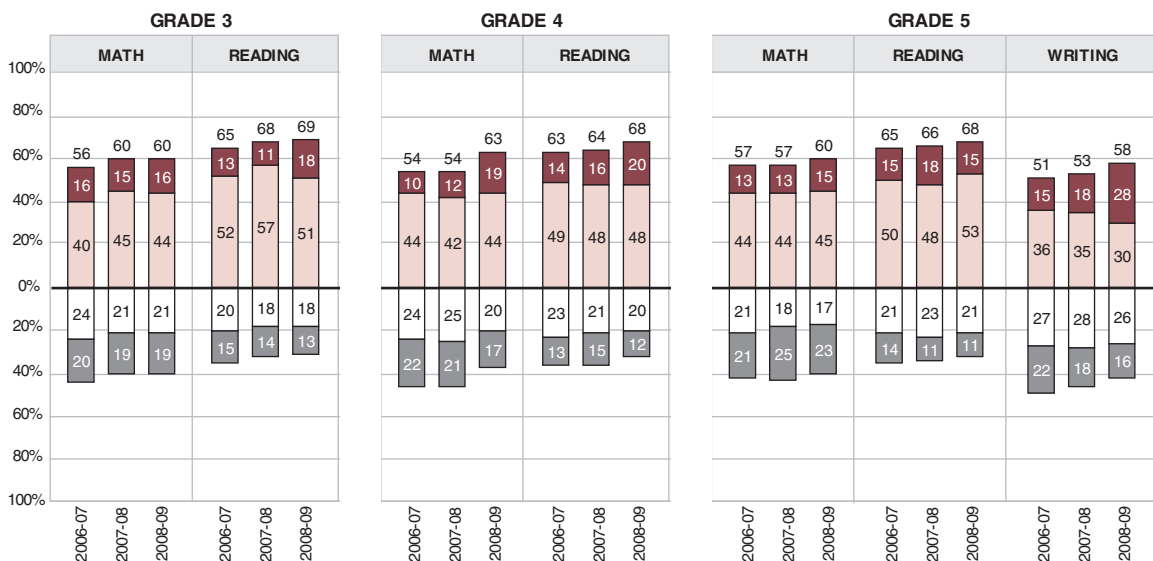
Percent of students reaching proficiency

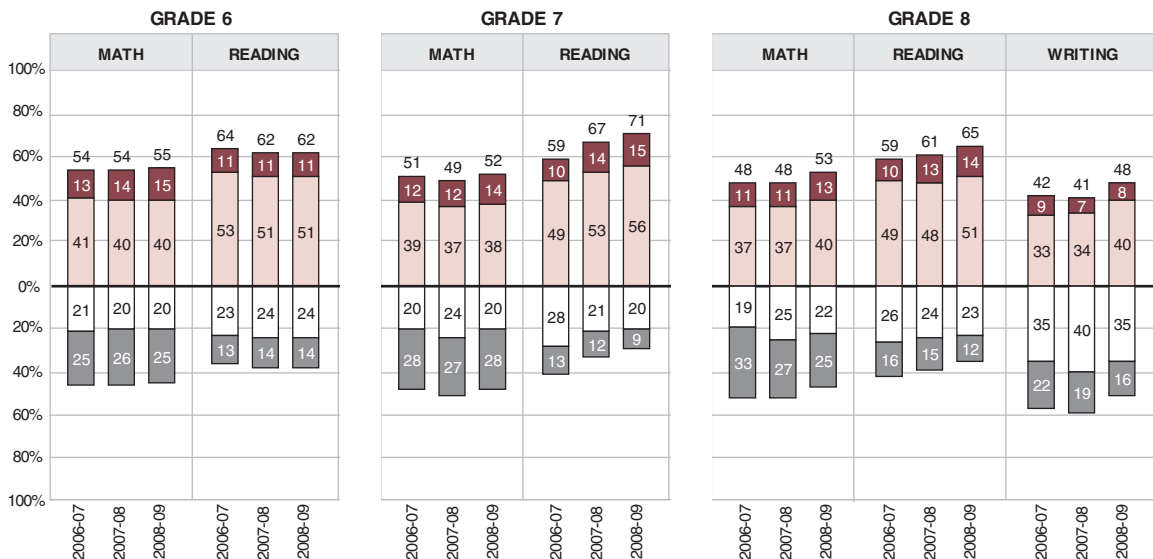

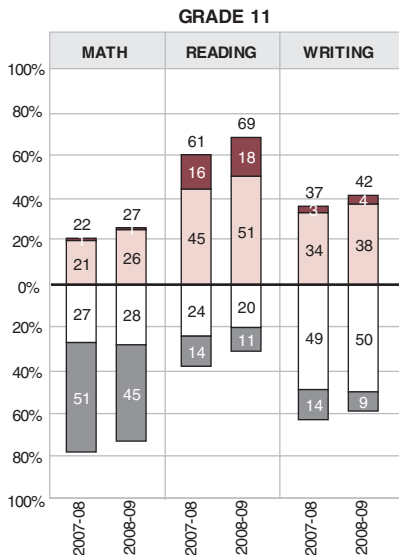
