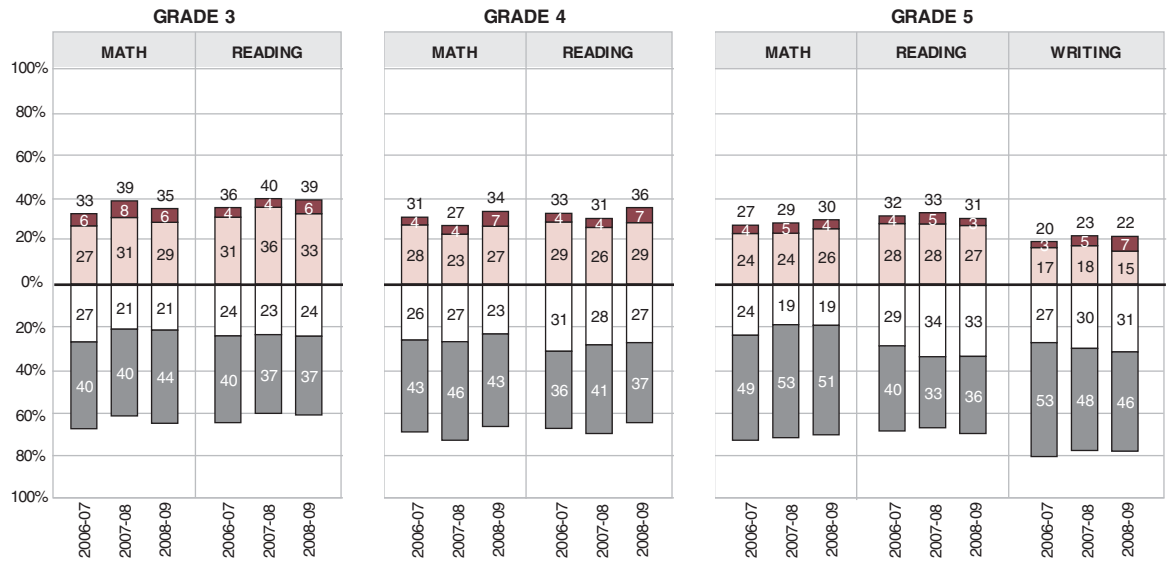

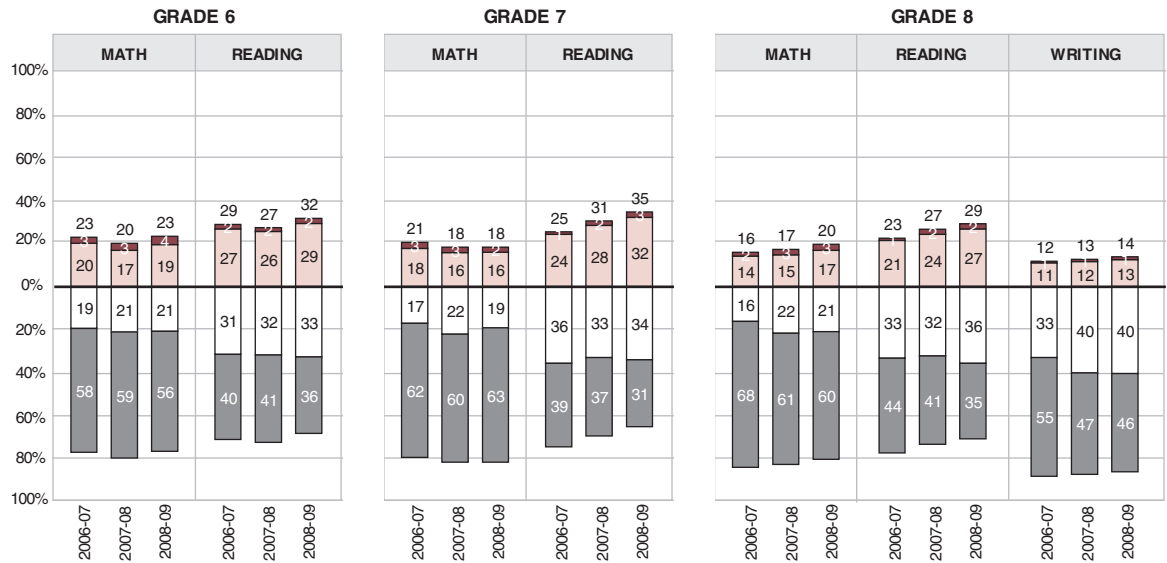

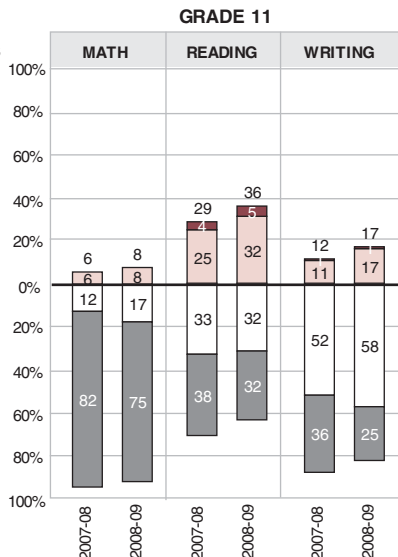

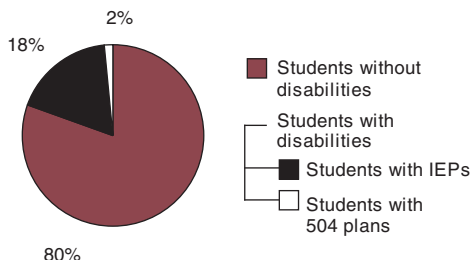

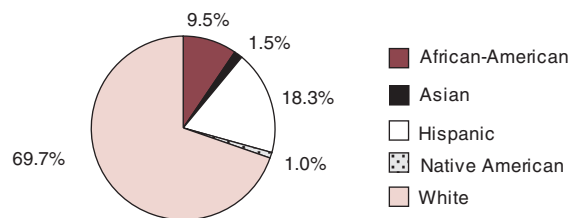

Students with IEPs from various racial / ethnic backgrounds

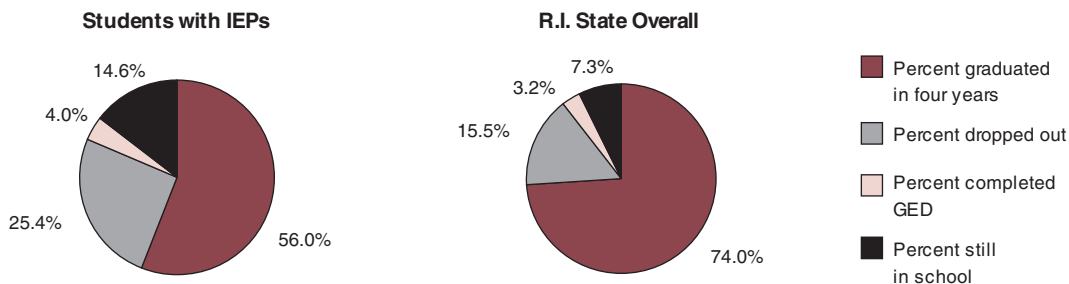

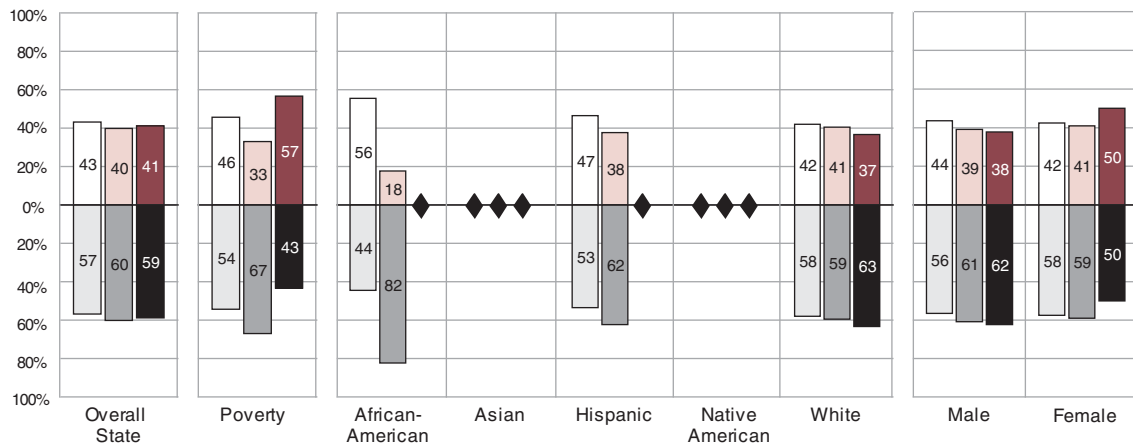

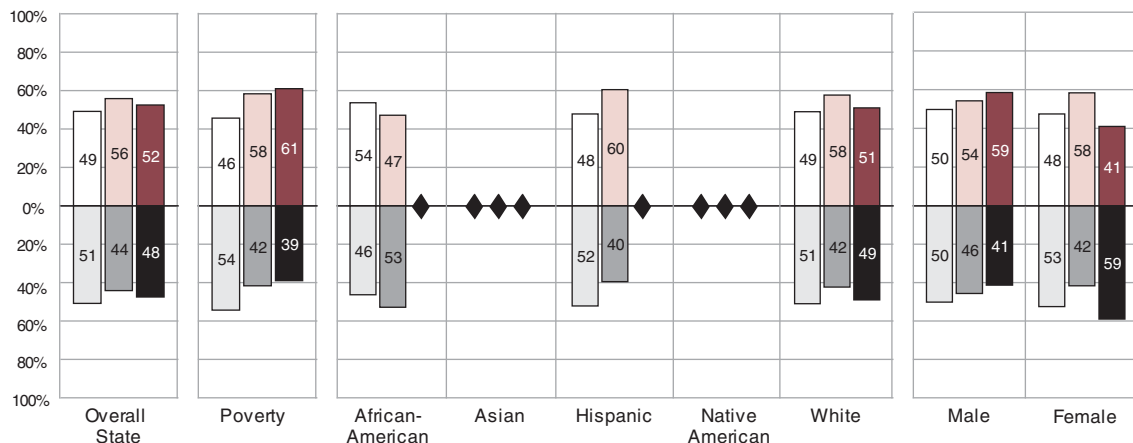

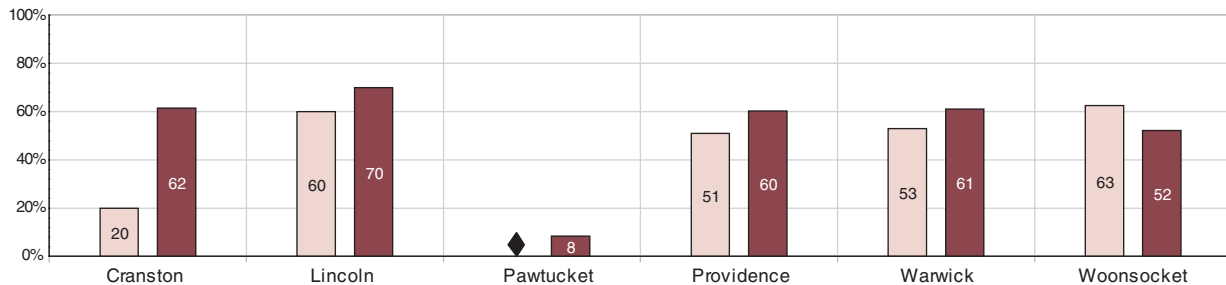

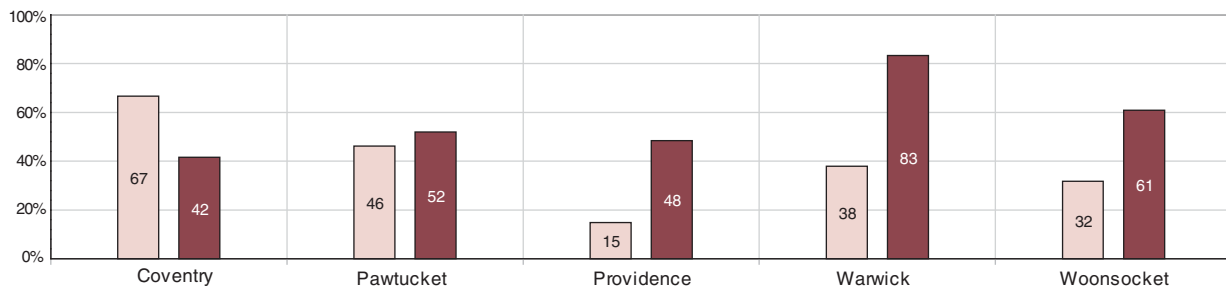

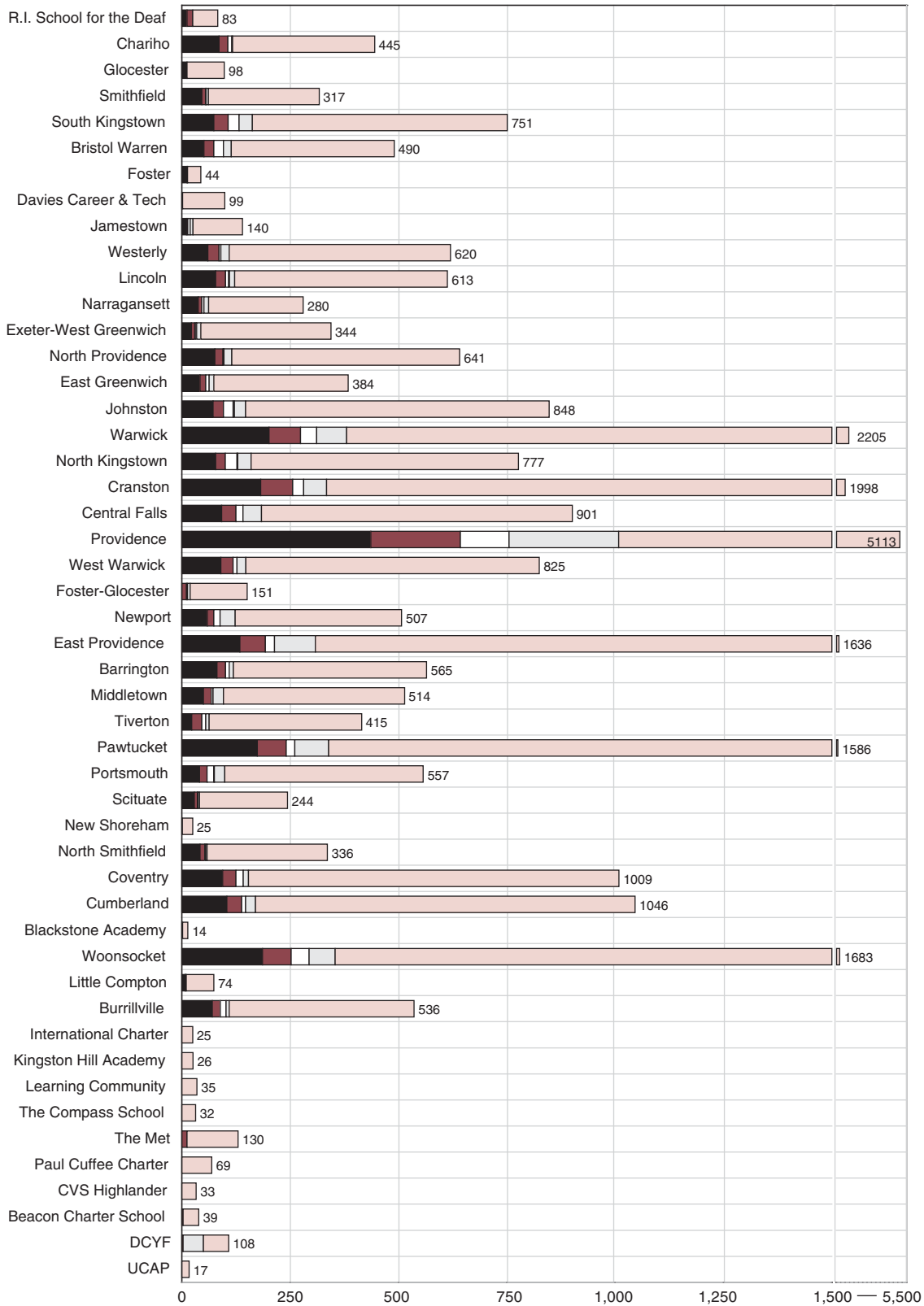
