


## Out-of-district expenditures (per pupil)



Districts are sorted by retiree benefits.

**Retiree benefits:** Health care, severance, life insurance, etc.

**Tuitions:** For district students who attend out-of-district public or nonpublic schools. (Little Compton and Jamestown pay tuition to send their students to high school out of district.)


**Transportation:** Costs incurred by students who attend private, parochial, or charter schools, as well as those whose district has no high school

**Other:** Adult education, community services, non-public/private school pass-through grants and textbooks

Note: In FY08 all New Shoreham students were educated in the district; there were no out-of-district placements. No retirement benefits were provided to staff in FY08.
