



The National Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP) is administered every two years to students in grades 4 and 8 in the subjects of reading and mathematics. The test is the only one given in all states. The results from the test are compared across states and to the U.S., thereby providing confirmation and comparison of achievement gains or losses. This report shows a comparison of the achievement results across the past three NAEP test cycles in Rhode Island and the U.S.

*Note: The NAEP Basic level is equivalent to the state's Proficient level.*
